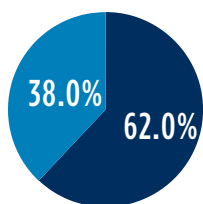
STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS



AVERAGE AGE

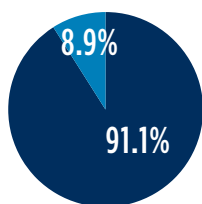
