PROGRAM PROBATION
A student who fails to perform satisfactorily in a professional-level course in the Medical Imaging Sciences Program will be placed on Program Probation. Professional-level courses are those listed on the degree plan as part of the Major Courses.
REMOVAL OF PROGRAM PROBATION
A student in the Medical Imaging Sciences Program who is placed on Program Probation is not eligible for removal of the Program Probation status. Students on Program Probation will remain on probation until they graduate or otherwise leave the program.
PROGRAM DISMISSAL
A student who fails to perform satisfactorily in two (2) professional-level courses in the Medical Imaging Sciences Program or fails on the second attempt of the same professional level course will be dismissed from the program. Professional-level courses are those listed on the degree plan as part of the Major Courses. (errata on: 11/21/2023)
