1. Purpose

- 1.1. To provide consistent admission criteria and processes for students applying to Baptist Health Sciences University (Baptist University).

2. Policy

- 2.1. The University has identified admission criteria designed to select those applicants deemed the best qualified to successfully complete the requirements for graduation, certification, and/or licensure.
- 2.2. If the University is aware of any circumstance that could adversely affect the applicant's ability to complete the program requirements or eligibility to take the licensure or certification examination, it may consider such circumstance in making the admission decision. If the applicant is known to be in default on a student loan or owes money to the University, the applicant may be denied admission/readmission.
- 2.3. Applicants who submit all required components of an application for each respective program are ranked based on the strength of those components, with admission offered to the most competitive applicants.
- 2.4. The University considers all applicants without regard to race, color, national origin, ethnicity, sex, sexual orientation, gender, gender identity, disability, religion, or age.
