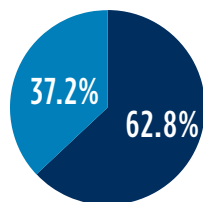
STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS

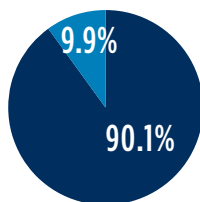
