1. Purpose

- 1.1. To ensure compliance with reporting crime statistics as mandated by Tennessee law TCA 38-10-101 et seq. (College and University Security Information Act).
- 1.2. To ensure compliance with the various components of the Clery Act.

2.1. The University will meet the reporting requirements as defined by the Tennessee law TCA 38-10-101 et seq. through implementation of the Tennessee Incident Based Reporting System (TIBRS).

2.2. Annual Reporting Requirements

- 2.2.1. The University will publish an annual report of crimes committed on campus. This is report will include crime statistic information for the most recent three year academic period and meet other informational requirements of the law.
- 2.2.2. The annual University Security Information Report will be available electronically. A copy of this report will available to each person who submits an application for admission or upon request of those who are students or employees.
