### **1. Purpose**

- 1.1. To define student responsibilities at Baptist Health Sciences University (BHSU).

### **2. Policy**

- 2.1. Students' responsibilities include, but are not necessarily limited to:
- 2.1.1. Abiding by all published policies, regulations, and standards of the University, including any revisions published during the academic year.
  - 2.1.2. Attending planned learning experiences (classroom, internship and clinical) to achieve course objectives and successful application of knowledge in the practice setting.
  - 2.1.3. If a student chooses not to participate in a planned learning experience for any reason, including COVID-19, their progression may be delayed.
    - 2.1.3.1. Professional licensing requirements established by the State of Tennessee and/or national accreditation/certification standards require all students to participate in a specified amount of clinical hours involving direct patient care. If students choose not to participate in the clinical experiences for any reason, including the COVID-19 pandemic, their progression may be delayed.
    - 2.1.3.2. Students are aware of the risks associated with planned learning experiences which include, but are not limited to, physical or psychological injury, pain, suffering, contagiousness, illness, temporary or permanent disability, economic or emotional loss, and/or death. By participating in the planned learning experiences, students acknowledge they have been made aware of risks, known or unknown, associated with or attributable to their planned learning experiences including, but not limited to, the COVID-19 pandemic.
  - 2.1.4. Satisfying all financial obligations to the University.
  - 2.1.5. Demonstrating respect for the rights of others in interactions with administration, faculty, students, and patients and staff of University-affiliated outside agencies.
  - 2.1.6. Participating in the purposeful evaluation of courses, programs and/or activities.
