1. Purpose

1.1. To define the rights of the students at Baptist Health Sciences University (BHSU).

2. Policy

- 2.1. Students enrolled in any program or course at BHSU have the right to:
 - 2.1.1. A course syllabus that includes learning outcomes, course requirements, and evaluation process.
 - 2.1.2. The opportunity to discuss, inquire, and express their views in the classroom, in conference, and in the practice setting through appropriate forums, or through written communication, provided the student does so with civility, and in accordance with the Standards of Student Conduct.
 - 2.1.3. A fair and timely academic and performance evaluation based upon the course learning outcomes and course requirements.
 - 2.1.4. Protection of confidentiality regarding release of information from student files in accordance with institutional, state, and federal guidelines.
 - 2.1.5. Be respected as a unique individual and to be treated fairly.
