1. Purpose

- 1.1. To provide an overview of Baptist Health Sciences University College of Osteopathic Medicine's (BUCOM) strategy for supporting and developing graduate medical education.

2. Policy

- 2.1. Collaboration with Baptist Memorial Medical Education (BMME)
 - 2.1.1. BUCOM will collaborate with BMME in all efforts to develop Graduate Medical Education (GME).
- 2.2. Supporting Graduate Medical Education
 - 2.2.1. BUCOM partners with Baptist Memorial Health Care Corporation (BMHCC) clinical education sites and other hospitals with existing GME programs in Arkansas, Mississippi, and Tennessee.
 - 2.2.2. BUCOM supports these programs by providing educational resources to support resident and faculty development. Resources may include library access, educational programming, simulation experiences, etc. based upon identified needs in support of the residency program.
- 2.3. Developing Graduate Medical Education
 - 2.3.1. BUCOM will explore developing or expanding GME at clinical education sites not associated with Baptist Memorial Health Care Corporation (BMHCC).
 - 2.3.2. BUCOM will provide support in the form of feasibility studies, sponsoring institution application assistance, individual program application assistance, and educational resources.
 - 2.3.3. BUCOM designates leadership positions dedicated to GME development (Assistant Dean for GME).
- 2.4. Partnering with individual Graduate Medical Education Programs
 - 2.4.1. BUCOM will partner with GME programs affiliated with each core clinical site to provide third- and fourth-year student rotations and increase student success in the National Resident Matching Program (NRMP).
 - 2.4.2. BUCOM will provide faculty development for residents and faculty to enhance skills as medical educators.

3. Definitions

3.1. Baptist Memorial Medical Education (BMME)

3.1.1. BMME is the BMHCC entity that develops and oversees all BMHCC GME programs. It serves as the Sponsoring Institution (SI) and Designated Institutional Official (DIO) for all BMHCC GME programs.
