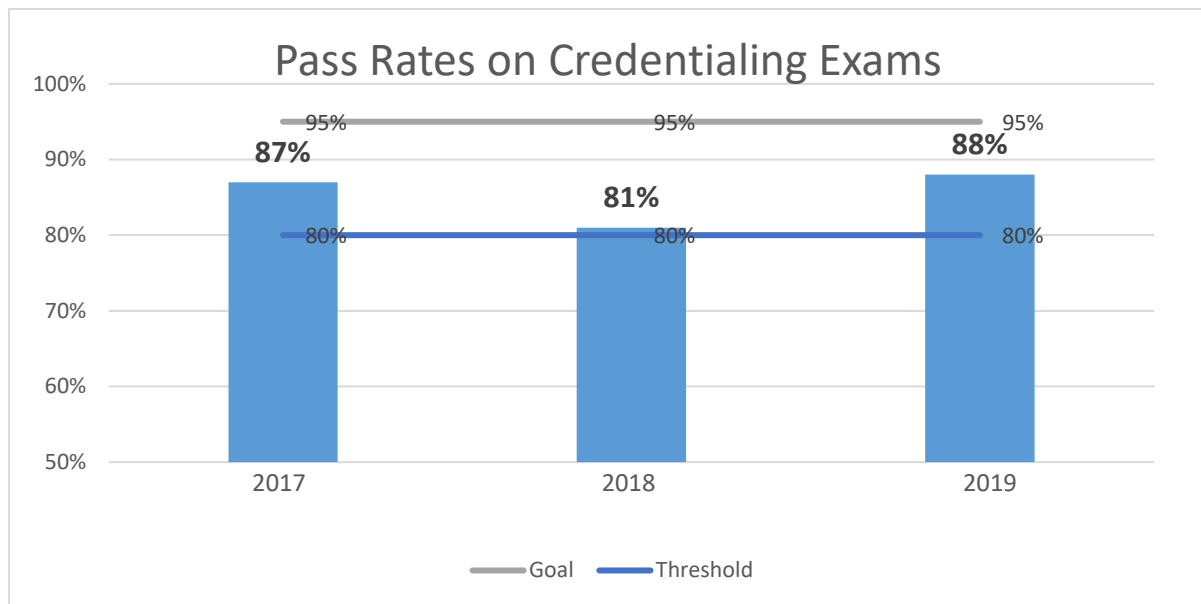


Professional Licensure/Certification Examinations


Beginning in 2019, in addition to tracking annual pass rates on licensure/credentialing exams, the Institutional Effectiveness Office began tracking graduation cohorts' student achievement and disaggregating by demographic groups. The table below shows that all groups exceed the threshold of acceptability of 80%. . Two groups (Pell Recipients and White students) exceeded the goal of 95%.

Notes: 231 students graduated fall 2018 thru summer 2019. Of those, 156 had clinical majors and sat for national licensing/credentialing exams for which their major areas of study prepared them. The graph above shows how many of these students passed the exams on their first attempt, where data is available.
