*For the Post-Master's to DNP Pathway:

- Up to 14 hours of block credit can be awarded for the Post Master's to DNP, based upon a gap analysis. A gap analysis will be completed on each applicant.
- Block credit will be considered for the following courses: NSG 707, NSG 708, NSG 709, NSG 711, NSG 712, and NSG 714.
- Up to 2 hours can be awarded based upon an individual Gap Analysis and Credit by Prior Learning. Credit by Prior Learning may be received for Graduate Competency Lab 1 (NSG 706) and Lab II (NSG 710) based upon Gap Analysis and submission of a portfolio.
- NSG 704 and NSG 705 are required and may be transferred from another school.
- If current in advanced nursing practice, the student will not have to repeat advanced pathophysiology or advanced health assessment.
- Advanced Pharmacology will need to be repeated for any courses >5 years old.
