Transfer Applicants (60+ Hours of College Level Credit Earned) must:

- 1. Submit transcripts from all colleges attended.
- 2. Complete 60 hours of college level credit from a regionally accredited college/university. Of the 60 hours, 24 hours must transfer toward the general education core curriculum.
- 3. Earn a minimum grade point average 2.50 (4.0 grade-point scale) on all college credit earned.
- 4. Submit an application for admission with a \$25.00 non-refundable application fee.
- 5. Submit a final official transcript verifying final grades from the semester currently attending. Admission is contingent upon receipt of final transcripts and grades.
- 6. Participate in an admissions interview.
- 7. Complete English Composition I prior to acceptance into the program.
- 8. Comply with the citizenship/residency requirement for all applicants. (Refer to the section Citizenship/Residency Requirement).
- 9. Upon acceptance to Baptist College:
 - Submit a \$100.00 non-refundable enrollment deposit.
 - Submit a background check prior to registration for classes. For more information, see the section on Criminal Background Checks.
 - Attend orientation. Dates for orientation will be sent upon acceptance to the College.
 - Submit the student health form provided by Baptist College upon acceptance to the College.
