Transfer Applicants (60+ Hours of College Level Credit Earned) must:

1. Submit transcripts from all colleges attended.
2. Complete 60 hours of college level credit from a regionally accredited college/university. Of the 60 hours, 24 hours must transfer toward the general education core curriculum.
3. Earn a minimum grade point average 2.50 (4.0 grade-point scale) on all college credit earned.
4. Submit an application for admission with a \$25.00 non-refundable application fee.
5. Submit a final official transcript verifying final grades from the semester currently attending. Admission is contingent upon receipt of final transcripts and grades.
6. Participate in an admissions interview.
7. Complete English Composition I prior to acceptance into the program.
8. Comply with the citizenship/residency requirement for all applicants. (Refer to the section Citizenship/Residency Requirement).
9. Upon acceptance to Baptist College:
 - Submit a \$100.00 non-refundable enrollment deposit.
 - Submit a background check prior to registration for classes. For more information, see the section on Criminal Background Checks.
 - Attend orientation. Dates for orientation will be sent upon acceptance to the College.
 - Submit the student health form provided by Baptist College upon acceptance to the College.
