



Baptist College of Health Sciences Cultural Exchange Club Constitution

Preamble

We, the students at Baptist College of Health Sciences (BCHS), by and with the consent of the faculty, in order to develop individual responsibility, promote cultural diversity awareness through activities that unify the students socially and educationally, and to advance the general welfare of the college, do ordain and establish this Constitution for the Cultural Exchange Club of the Baptist College of Health Sciences.

Article I: Name

The name of this organization shall be the Baptist College of Health Sciences Cultural Exchange Club, hereafter called CEC.

Article II: Purpose

The main goal of the CEC is to educate BCHS community on different cultural practices, to provide the students with an opportunity to experience cultural diversity, promoting peace and acceptance, and to provide students with an opportunity to share their culture with others within the vision, mission, and values of Baptist College of Health Sciences.

Article III: Membership

Any student enrolled at Baptist College of Health Sciences may be an active member of the CEC.

Article IV: Officers

The elected officers of the organization shall be: President, Vice President, Treasurer, and Secretary

Article V: Duties of Officers

The President shall preside over all meetings, represent the CEC in all situations requiring official representations, see that the constitution is upheld and that all officers properly execute the duties of their offices.

The Vice President may at any time be called upon to assume the duties of the President, either at the latter's request or in absence of the President. He or she shall automatically become President in the event of the President's leaving BCHS or being in any other way rendered incapable of fulfilling his or her duties.



The Secretary is responsible for the duties assigned to him/her by the President, taking role at meetings and keeping an accurate record of all the business taken care of at the meeting. He/she is also responsible for all correspondence between the club and its members.

The Treasurer is responsible for any fundraising activities for the club and to keep track of all money spent and received.

Article VI: Elections

The officers will be elected once a year by the members of CEC at a general meeting by a simple majority of votes. Voting will be done by secret ballot and no person shall cast more than one vote. The term of office will be one year.

Article VII: Voting

All members present at the meeting are eligible to vote. A quorum will be considered a simple majority.

Article VIII: Amendments

The CEC Constitution may be amended by a two-thirds majority vote of members present at the meeting when voting takes place.

Article IX: Meetings

CEC meetings shall be decided by its members. Special meetings may be called by the President.
