To return Title IV funds in accordance with 34 CFR 668.164. (Federal

Financial Aid Manual)

Policy:

Baptist Memorial College of Health Sciences will meet federal regulations

for Return of Title IV funds.

Terms:

<u>Repayment</u>: funds owed when the cash disbursement (excluding FFEL Program loans) to a student was greater than the amount of the student's expenses before the student withdrew from school. The difference is considered an overpayment and must be repaid. A portion of the overpayment must be collected from the student and returned to Federal

Title IV programs.

Procedure:

Responsible Party

Steps

Admissions/Records

- 1. Informs the Federal Financial Aid
 Officer of Title IV participant's failure
 to complete the enrollment period.
 Failure to complete includes:
 - Officially withdrawing
 - Dropping out
 - Expulsion
 - Taking an unapproved leave of absence or
 - Failing to return from an approved leave of Absence

Federal Financial Aid Officer

2. Calculates overpayment in accordance with U.S. Department of Education guidelines and requests appropriate repayment from student. All repayment documentation will be retained in the student's Federal Financial Aid file.

- 3. Places any repayment amount in the respective Title IV aid accounts in the following order as mandated by federal regulations:
 - Federal Pell Grant Program
 - Federal SEOG Program
 - Other Title IV funded programs including Tennessee Student Assistance Program
 - Other Federal, State, private or institutional aid programs
 - Federal Family Education Loan Program (FFELP)
