

Radiation Therapy Program Job Placement Rate

Job placement rate is defined as the number of graduates employed in the radiologic sciences compared to the number of graduates actively seeking employment in radiation therapy within twelve months of graduation. Not actively seeking employment is defined as: (1.) graduate fails to communicate with program officials regarding employment status after multiple attempts; (2.) graduate is unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation; (3.) graduate is unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours; (4.) graduate is on active military duty; and/or (5.) graduate is continuing education
